Logistical Information

The Gathering is being held at [Camp Capers](#), a large and beautiful Camp and Conference Center along the Guadalupe River, run by the Episcopal Diocese of West Texas. The dates of this event are Monday, Oct. 30, 2023 – Friday, Nov. 3, 2023, and *it is exclusively for intermediate to advanced Native American Flute players.*

If you will be flying in, the nearest airport is in San Antonio, TX (SAT). There is no transportation provided from the airport to Camp Capers, so it is recommended that attendees rent a car and drive. The camp is approximately 1 hour from the SAT airport. If you wish to share a ride with others, that can be indicated during registration.

There are three price points for the Gathering depending on the type of lodging you choose. The event fee covers all meals, lodging, and instruction for 4 days and nights. Common dietary restrictions are easily accommodated and should also be indicated upon registration.

Lodge - Single Room - \$1350 – The single room lodging option provides the most privacy. It includes a room for one person, with two beds and a private bath.

Lodge - Double Room - \$1050 - A double room is the same room with a private bath and two beds as described in the ‘Single Room’ option but is occupied by two people.

Cabin - Bunkhouse - \$750 - A cabin room has 12 bunkbeds, two full bathrooms (toilet and showering facilities are in separated spaces), and multiple sinks. Each cabin will be male or female. At this time, no more than 8 people may choose the cabin option. The number may increase later, depending on the number of people who register.

Payment Policy

Payment options include paying in full at the time of registration or putting down a deposit of 50% or more of the cost. The remaining balance must be paid no later than September 15, 2023.

Cancellation Policy

If you must cancel for any reason, please let the Gathering Coordinator (Julia Gatliff) know as soon as possible. You may reach her via email at flutetree@gmail.com or by text at (512) 673-3132. Refunds for the full amount you've paid are available until October 9, 2023. If you must cancel between October 9, 2023 and the Gathering start date, October 30, 2023, no refund can be given.

In the unlikely event that FluteTree Foundation must cancel the event, the amount you've paid is fully refundable.

Rules and Regulations of Camp Capers

All participants must sign an Assumption of Risk Form, required by Camp Capers, as part of the registration process. The form will be emailed to you upon registration. The Gathering has liability insurance in place as provided by Camp Capers. In addition, we must all follow the following Camp Capers policies:

- PETS, FIREARMS, ILLEGAL DRUGS AND FIREWORKS ARE STRICTLY FORBIDDEN ON THE PREMISES.
- Camp Capers is not responsible for personal sports equipment.
- It is expected that all groups will comply with state and local laws.

Covid-19 Policy

Regarding masking, testing, and vaccinations, we will adhere to whatever policy Camp Capers has in place at the time of our event. Currently there are no Covid-19 requirements at Camp Capers.
